

HOW TO GET TO COBALT STUDIOS

FLIGHT / TRAIN / BUS

Taking any form of public transportation will most likely route you through New York City. Flying into **Stewart International Airport** is the only direct way to Cobalt Studios

Stewart International Airport

There is no mass transit from Stewart Airport. Either rent a car or call us in advance with your flight plan and we might be able to pick you up. Taxis are available once you arrive at Stewart Airport, and you can call for one in advance to for your return flight – (845) 794-4040 (Yellow Cab Co.) = \$100.00

Flying into LaGuardia, JFK, or Newark Airports

To get to White Lake from LaGuardia, JFK, or Newark you can:

- A) Rent a car to drive up the whole way (2-3 hours)
- B) Take a train or bus from Midtown New York to a station closer to us
 - You can reach the Midtown transportation hubs (Grand Central Station, Penn Station, or Port Authority) from any of the airports by either bus or shuttle. The easiest but most expensive way to reach Midtown from the airport is by hailing a Taxi, it shouldn't run you much more than \$50

Traveling by Train from NYC

The two options for train travel are from Grand Central Station to Beacon, NY or from Penn Station to Middletown, NY. The train to Beacon it is a direct route without transfers, while taking the train to Middletown requires a transfer. We will pick you up from either train station, however Beacon is an hour's drive and is close to Stewart Airport so we would coordinate your pickup with any airport pickups we might have from other students. Middletown is about a 40 minute drive so it can be more flexible with pickups.

How to get to Beacon from New York City: From **Grand Central Station** take the **Metro-North Railroad's Hudson Line** with the destination of **Poughkeepsie** (Puh-Kip-See). You will then get off at the **Beacon** stop and give Rachel a call when you arrive (845-701-1632) <http://web.mta.info/mnr/html/planning/schedules/schedules.htm>

How to get to Middletown from New York City: From **Penn Station** take the **New Jersey Transit** line to **Secaucus, NJ**. From Secaucus, you will take either train with the destination of **Middletown** or **Port Jervis** and get off at the **Middletown** stop on either train line.

Traveling by Bus from NYC

There is currently no bus service on the weekends. If you are traveling on the weekend you will need to take one of the trains, however, the bus is a very convenient option for weekday travel.

--From **Port Authority Bus Terminal** you will take the **Coach USA Shortline Bus** to the **Monticello** station. <https://www.coachusa.com/>
