## **HOW TO GET TO COBALT STUDIOS**

### FLIGHT / BUS / TRAIN

Taking any form of public transportation will most likely route you through New York City. Flying into **Stewart International Airport** is the only direct way to Cobalt Studios

#### **Stewart International Airport**

There is no public transit from Stewart Airport. Either rent a car or call us in advance with your flight plan and we might be able to pick you up. Taxis are available once you arrive at Stewart Airport, and you can call for one in advance to for your return flight - (845) 794-4040 (Yellow Cab Co.) = \$100.00

#### Flying into LaGuardia, JFK, or Newark Airports

To get to White Lake from LaGuardia, JFK, or Newark you can:

- A) Rent a car to drive up the whole way (2-3 hours)
- B) Take a train or bus from New York City to a station closer to us
  - You can reach the Midtown transportation hubs (Grand Central Station, Penn Station, or Port Authority)
    from any of the airports by either bus or shuttle. The easiest but most expensive way to reach Midtown
    from the airport is by hailing a Taxi, it shouldn't run you much more than \$50

#### **Traveling by Bus from NYC**

Taking the bus from **Port Authority** to the **Monticello** station is the most direct public transportation option to get to Cobalt Studios. There are no transfers and the bus terminal on this end is a 10 minute drive, making pickups very easy. During the week, the bus runs about every two hours. Weekend service is more limited, but has a few convenient departure times.

--From **Port Authority Bus Terminal** you will take the **Coach USA Shortline Bus** to the **Monticello Shortline Terminal**. Visit <a href="https://www.coachusa.com/">https://www.coachusa.com/</a> for schedules and tickets.

# **Traveling by Train from NYC**

The two options for train travel are from Grand Central Station to Beacon, NY or from Penn Station to Middletown, NY. The train to Beacon it is a direct route without transfers, while taking the train to Middletown requires a transfer. We will pick you up from either train station, however Beacon is an hour's drive and is close to Stewart Airport so we would coordinate your pickup with any airport pickups we might have from other students. Middletown is about a 40 minute drive so it can be more flexible with pickups.

<u>How to get to Beacon from New York City</u>: From Grand Central Station take the Metro-North Railroad's *Hudson Line* with the destination of **Poughkeepsie** (Puh-Kip-See). <u>How to get to Middletown from New York City</u>: From Penn Station take the New Jersey Transit line to Secaucus, NJ. From Secaucus, you will take either train with the destination of **Middletown**, NY or Port Jervis and get off at the **Middletown**, NY stop on either train line.
